

THE NEED


- High level of youth unemployment
- Only 10.4% of enterpreneurs age15-29
- "Employment in public service provides lower wages but a safe job and stable future", majority of Serbian youth say





REASONS FOR NOT STARTING OWN BUSINESS

- No access to financing
- Lack of knowledge, skills and experience
- High level of risk
- Low expectancy of success
- Poor business climate
- 52% say: "If I had favourable loan, I would probably step into entepreneurship"





(SUPER)STEPS

- Call for applications for new business ideas
- Pre-Selection of candidates for training
- Training / Education (B&A, financial education)
- Final- Selection of business ideas to be financed

– Finance

- Setting up of new businesses
- Ongoing support and monitoring








NEW ENTERPRENEURS
